### Horizon Criteria

- \* Grades 4 12
- \* Students served in Reading/Language Arts and Social Studies
- All subject area teachers have 30 hour G/T training required by TEA
- \* Students identified in May of each year
- \* If identified in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade do not have to retest to stay in Horizon until graduation
- \* If do not qualify in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade can re-test each spring
- \* 4<sup>th</sup> -12<sup>th</sup> grade students assigned to G/T trained teacher (not a pull out class)



### Horizon (grades 3 - 12) Criteria

- \* 1. Teacher Observation Inventory (TOI)
- \* 2. Student Composition
- \* 3. Otis-Lennon School Ability Test (OLSAT)
- \* 4. NWEA MAP ELAR
- \* 5. Iowa Test of Basic Skills (ITBS)-Social Studies Composite

Must meet criteria in 4 out of 5 to qualify for Horizon



### Horizon Secondary

- \* Grades 6 12
- \* Students served in Reading/Language Arts and Social Studies
- \* All subject area teachers have 30 hour G/T training required by TEA
- \* Students identified in May of each year
- \* If identified, do not have to retest to stay in Horizon
- \* If do not qualify can re-test each spring
- \* 6<sup>th</sup> 8<sup>th</sup> grade specific identified Horizon Reading/Language Arts classes (Pre-AP)
- \* Students served through Pre-AP social studies classes at Middle school
- \* Students served in Pre-AP and AP designated Horizon classes in Reading/Language Arts and Social Studies in grades 9 12

# Students served in math and science

#### MATH

- \*Students are scheduled into a Navigation Math class at Magee and Middle School (Pre-AP) which is accelerated to the next grade level TEKS
- \*Students in 8th grade take Pre-AP Algebra I and receive high school credit for that class
- High school students are served through Pre-AP or AP classes designated as Navigation

#### Science

- \*Students are served in their science class at Magee
- Students can choose to be scheduled into a Pre-AP Science class at Middle School.
- High school students are served through Pre-AP or AP classes designated as Navigation
